



Mislabelling of fur is rife!

- Real fur is used as trim on garments, toys, hair trinkets etc, or as all-fur hats, jackets and coats.



- Animal fur is often mislabelled as faux fur, or under exotic sounding names such as Chat de Chine. Many cases of mislabelling have been discovered in South Africa recently.
- Real fur is routinely dyed unnatural colours and sheared, giving it the appearance of faux fur to the untrained eye.
